A challenge to the leaders of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints ....

Let the people go ... Let them be free to "learn from the best books."

As proclaimed in the 11<sup>th</sup> Article of Faith... 11. "We claim the privilege of worshiping Almighty God according to the dictates of our own conscience, and allow all men the same privilege, let them worship how, where, or what they may."

This will not detract from the LDS church, but will enhance it ... even one-hundred fold. A simple statement from General Conference, or a Priesthood Bulletin such as:

There are some among us who believe the Urantia Book is that "greater things" spoken of in the Book of Mormon. The members of this church are free to study it and embrace it without any repercussion from this church or its leaders. A step further welcome would be such as:

Within its pages is not only the cosmology of the Universe and a greater understanding of man's ascension through it, but the Urantia Papers contain the more full account of Jesus entire life—from His youth, through the teenage and young adult years—through to his public ministry, trial, death and resurrection. We invite all mankind to draw closer to our Creator/Father/Brother ... Jesus of Nazareth, the son of man.
